Greetings Lenten journey mates,

I pray that you have been as blessed by our journey with Simon Peter as I have. It is good to be reminded that even "the Rock" struggled with faith... just like we do. The daily questions and prayers sent out by email offer all of us a chance to reflect more deeply on our own faith journey and to connect with God in meaningful ways.

We'll be doing a Stations of Peter service as part of our Wandering Hearts journey with Peter. I am confident it will be a transformative way of engaging with the events of Holy Thursday. I hope you will make it a priority to come out and welcome our friends in Christ from other churches to this community worship service.

All are invited to participate in the Good Friday Seven Last Words Service hosted by Emory Grove UMC at noon (March 29th). Come and stay for one word or for all seven and be blessed. In addition, you can enjoy a delicious Good Friday Fish Fry prepared by the men of Emory Grove. Eat there or take home dinner for your family.

Finally, join us for a joyous celebration of Easter Sunday, on March 31st, at 10 AM. With music and word, we'll remind ourselves again that Christ is Risen!

Lent is a time for introspection and reflection in preparation for the celebration of new life through the resurrection on Easter Sunday (March 31, this year). Join me as I reflect on last year.

It is no secret that 2023 was a challenging year financially for Covenant, with a burst water main pipe, sanctuary leaks, and HVAC problems. But with your generous support and the foresight of leaders before us who provided a financial cushion for emergencies, we were able to continue the ministry of our church: Offering vibrant worship with inspiring music that is also available online through our tech program; providing food through our Little Free Pantry; hosting scout troops and AA meetings; providing space for a well respected preschool; reviving our children's Sunday school and strengthening our adult education programs;

participating in the homeless resource day; offering groceries monthly, serving between 200 and 300 people; hosting the Men's Fellowship and reviving the children's Secret Shop; hosting a holiday brunch for 80 neighbors in December; and supporting Stepping Stones and the Lord's Table and so much more.

It happened because you supported Covenant financially. Thank you.








Join us **Sunday Evenings** for our Lenten study of *The Longest Psalm; Day-by-Day Responses to Divine Self-*

what the facts of our present reality seem to tell us."


